AASuccess is a non-profit organization dedicated to nurturing and advancing professional life skills among its participants, who include both high school and college students, primarily of Asian descent. Our core programs—comprising Scholarship, Giving Back, Life Skills, and Business Management—are developed to provide a structure for the development of these students, over the critical periods in life when the students are enrolled as committed members of the organization.

Although the AASuccess Handbook prescribes how to guide the students at various stages of their youth, the handbook is used in a flexible manner so as to best suit AASuccess' staff and professional volunteers in assisting each individual student, pursuant to his or her specific needs and situations. While we hope to mentor deserving students from the beginning of high school until graduation, then continue on with them during their college years, we recognize that students may enter the AASuccess Programs at various points in their youth and young adulthood. Our programs are designed to be adjusted and tempered to meet the students' "point" in life and guide them into the standard program format, as is age appropriate.

All AASuccess student members are required to serve the community in alignment with our mission, and to support the organization in various capacities. In doing so, the students directly learn and apply valuable professional life skills, while supporting the organization that supports them in return.

Everyone involved in AASuccess operates and succeeds through the cycle of contributing to a "community effort", then benefiting from the same community in effect.
